Investment in Abbey

- As well as the strategic growth sites being built out at Marleigh and Springstead village, significant change is also underway in Abbey ward.
- Over the next few years, up to £150 million is set to be invested in the area including;
 - 120 new homes, replacement community centre and library, pre-school, shops and open spaces as part of the East Barnwell regeneration scheme
 - Options are being explored for modern, sustainable housing at Ekin Road estate
 - A range of community projects co-designed and funded to improve quality of life
 - New sports and leisure facilities
 - Creating new jobs, supporting the local economy and improving people's lives




Image shows complex nature of the inter-connected programmes of work across Abbey ward, with more to come including potential works at Beehive centre, and Abbey football stadium.
