**Matter for Decision:** To agree progress on long term transport strategy work being undertaken by the County Council.

**Why the decision had to be made (and any alternative options):** See officer's report.

**The Executive Councillor's decisions:**

- 1) Welcome the progress to date on the LTTS;
- 2) Confirm the City Council's commitment to further development of transport strategies and the investigation of all appropriate measures, including the potential impact of demand management; and
- 3) Support the County Council in appropriate bids into the Local Transport Fund, Transport Innovation Fund and other sources of Government funding.
- 4) Request the County Council to publish detailed transport forecasts and implications of the impact of each major development site in the Cambridge sub-region on the city's transport infrastructure.

**Reasons for the decision:** The Executive Councillor had requested the special Scrutiny Committee to provide an opportunity to comment on the on-going work being undertaken on the Strategy and to inform the County Council, and the consultants working on behalf of the County Council, of the City Council's view.

**Scrutiny consideration:** The Scrutiny Committee considered and approved the recommendations by 4 votes to 0.
