5 Draft Landscape and Open Space Strategy for Cambridge Southern Fringe

Attached are copies of a draft concept for the two principal landscape and open space areas of Cambridge Southern Fringe.

The two key areas relate to the lands to the south west of the "Trumpington Meadows" site west of Hauxton Road, and the "green corridor" between Hobson's Brook and the London-Cambridge rail line.

The strategy is the result of a recommended action in the approved Southern Fringe Area Development Framework (ADF) to undertake more detailed work to support the general recommendations contained in the ADF.

The plans have been prepared by the Landscape Partnership for Cambridge City

Council and South Cambridgeshire District Council, and the work commissioned by Cambridgeshire Horizons.

A draft report is currently being reviewed by officers and a verbal summary of its findings (including preliminary costs, ownership/management) will be presented to the reference group on May 24th.
