Why the decision had to be made (and any alternative options):	The Local Plan Inquiry ended on 30 th November 2005. The Inspector's report is expected in Spring 2006. The recommendations in the Report on how the Plan should be changed will be binding on the City Council. No other changes to the Local Plan can be made. Adoption must take place before 21 st July 2006. On adoption the 1996 Local Plan will cease to be of any significance.
