<b>Matter for Decision:</b>	The purpose of this report is to enable members to monitor progress on the planning and implementation of Community Development Projects in the Planning Obligations Strategy and to recommend a further list of schemes for development and potential funding.		
<b>Why the decision had to be made (and any alternative options):</b>	Since 2004, £1.698.855 has been received in Section106 contributions for Community Development projects of which £968.000 has been spent on or committed to specific schemes. Most of this expenditure has been in the form of grants to voluntary or charitable organisations to develop or improve the infrastructure of community facilities in response to the impact of new residential developments. As far as possible, grants have been used to enable the recipients to attract additional capital investment from other sources or to stimulate partnerships.
