



7 TO CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING NOTICES OF MOTION, NOTICE OF WHICH HAS BEEN GIVEN BY:

(a) Councillor Herbert

The Council thanks all retiring Councillors for their contributions to the city.

(b) Councillors Herbert & Blencowe

The Council believes that, to retain public confidence in the planning process, it is essential that all members of the Planning Committee are free at committee to make legitimate comment and reach their own individual conclusions when determining planning applications, free from undue external pressures.

(c) Councillor Blencowe

This Council notes that the recent removal of the public benches outside the front of the Guildhall reduced the incidence of aggressive anti-social drinking and related anti-social behaviour which has been associated with their use in recent years. The Council requests their removal until appropriate measures are in place to deal with street drinking in the city.

(d) Councillor Dryden

This Council wishes to support the Royal British Legion by asking the Executive Councillor for Customer Services and Resources to authorise letting the Guildhall at no cost for the Remembrance Festival that is held every year in November.

(e) Councillors Downham and Dryden

This Council supports a proposal for a memorial to the late Snowy Farr who was well known to many City residents, the memorial to take the form of a statue or artwork in the Petty Cury area which should be modest, child-friendly and accessible to sight-impaired

people. It should commemorate Snowy for his fundraising charity work in bringing his entertaining bike-cum-cart of tame animals to the City Centre. The Council calls on officers to prepare a report for the Leader on options for its siting and funding, and commissioning of the best possible design.
