<b>The Executive Councillor's decision(s):</b>	Agreed: To authorise officers to award the Council's Arts and Entertainments Print Services contract to Piggott Black Bear for a period of 3 years from 29 July 2008 to 29 July 2011 (with the Council's option to extend the contract for a further period up to 2 years) at a cost of £103,692 for 3 years or £172,820 for an extended contract.
