03/m/02 **APOLOGIES**

There were no apologies.

03/m/03 **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

Councillor Knowles declared a personal interest in 03/m/06 as the premises were situated in her Ward (West Chesterton).

03/m/04 **PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT LICENCE – CAMBRIDGE MEGABOWL,
HILLS ROAD****Resolved -**

To approve a provisional licence, subject to the following conditions:

1. Events to be held between the hours of 11:00 and 23:00 on Mondays to Wednesdays, 11:00 and 00:00 on Thursdays to Saturdays and 12:00 and 22:30 on Sundays only.
2. Permitted numbers to be agreed by the HEHWS, following consultation with the Fire Officer.
3. A noise report by an acoustic consultant shall be commissioned by the applicant to investigate the likelihood of noise disturbance to other businesses in the leisure complex and the escape of sound to the outside through the external structure. Any problems identified by the report shall be remedied by a suitable sound insulation scheme, submitted to the HEHWS for approval, before the scheme is implemented. The full licence shall only be issued once all necessary works are completed and no events may be held until this has been done.
4. Sanitary provision shall be installed to the satisfaction of the HEHWS.

5. The licence shall be reviewed by Members no later than six months after the premises commences operation.

03/m/05 **PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT LICENCE: REVIEW – MAN ON THE MOON, NORFOLK STREET**

Resolved -

To approve the licence subject to the existing conditions.

03/m/06 **PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT LICENCE: OLD SPRING, FERRY PATH**

The Committee considered an application to permit two events per week, Monday-Sunday for standard licensing hours.

Resolved -

To approve subject to the following conditions:

1. Only live "Jazz" type bands to be allowed.
2. Amplification shall be used only to reinforce the sound of the singer and acoustic instruments, such as the double bass. Amplified instruments are not permitted. The in-house sound system shall not be used during events.
3. Events only to be held in the single storey pitched roof section of the premises, adjacent to the Cycle Shop at 72 Chesterton Road on the Ferry Path elevation.
4. All other doors and windows to be kept shut at all times during performances. Main entrance / exit doors that allow general ingress and egress shall be kept closed so far as reasonably practicable during performances.
5. One steward to be present.
6. One event to be held per week Mondays to Saturdays, between 8 pm and 11 pm
7. A second event may be held each week on Sundays between 12 noon and 4 pm
8. Maximum Numbers admitted: 100
9. Number of Exits: Two
10. Fire Fighting Equipment: 1 x 6 litre AFFF type extinguisher behind the bar, 1 x 2kg CO2 type extinguisher adjacent to band.
11. Emergency Lighting: Maintained illuminated 'EXIT' notices, one above each exit door. Other non-maintained units within the premises.

03/m/07 **PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT LICENCE: RENEWALS - HAT & FEATHERS – PUBLIC HOUSE - BARTON ROAD**

The Licensing Officer advised the Committee that the landlord may have moved premises since the application had been made. The officers would check if the applicant wished to proceed with the renewal prior to formally notifying him of the Committee's decision.

Resolved -

Subject to the above, to approve subject to the existing conditions with an additional condition that not more than one event should be held per month.

03/m/08 APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF A SEX ESTABLISHMENT LICENCE: THE XXX ZONE , NEWMARKET ROAD

The applicant and his legal advisor (Mr Evans) were present. No other members of the public were present. Mr Evans stated that his client would be satisfied with the existing conditions as recommended for the renewal. Both the Head of Environmental Health and the Police offered no objection to the renewal as recommended.

The Chair questioned why the addresses of the objectors/supporters had been blanked out and asked the officers not to do this in future unless there was a justification for it.
