Councillor Nimmo-Smith spoke Bradnack and Councillor Barrett-Payton spoke in favour of the recommendation of Civic Affairs Committee on 9 May 2005.

Councillor Bradnack proposed and Councillor Durrant seconded the following amendment which was carried unanimously.

‘Add after City of Cambridge: ‘and that Civic Affairs Committee be asked to consider extension of the same privilege to the City of Szeged.’

Resolved (unanimously)

- 1 That Cambridge City Council, in recognition of the link of friendship enjoyed with the City of Heidelberg since 1957, and to mark the 40th anniversary of signing the Friendship Agreement with Heidelberg on 8th July, 1965, hereby admits the City of Heidelberg to the Freedom of the City of Cambridge.
- 2 That Civic Affairs Committee be asked to consider extension of the same privilege to the City of Szeged.’
