05/m/55 **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

05/m/56 **HACKNEY CARRIAGE FARE REVIEW 2005/ 2006**

The Head of Environmental Services (HES) presented the report.

**Resolved**

The Licensing Committee agreed the proposal not to accept the increases as requested but to accept those outlined in Paragraph 3.6 of this report (see Appendix C), and agreed that these be introduced as the Hackney Carriage Maximum Rates of Charges as from 12<sup>th</sup> September 2005.

05/m/57 **PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT LICENCE (NEW) – BIRD IN HAND PUBLIC HOUSE, NEWMARKET ROAD**

The Head of Environmental Services (HES) presented the report and detailed the potential concerns regarding noise. It was recommended that the license be deferred and delegated to HES subject to necessary works being completed. The Police Officer was concerned about customers' cars being parked in private parking spaces.

The Fire Officer considered it necessary to carry out fire safety works as a condition of the license.

### **Resolved**

Defer, because of the fire safety works considered necessary by the Fire Officer have not been carried out, and delegate to HES to approve and issue, once these have been satisfactorily completed. Then, subject to the following conditions:

1. Three events may be held, which shall finish by 11.00 p.m.
2. Seven days written notice shall be given to HES of each event permitted.
3. Doors and windows shall be kept shut during performances.
4. A noise limiter shall be provided and set to the satisfaction of HES, to control the volume of amplified music played.
5. All events shall be held in the bar area only. No events shall be held in the garden.
6. Maximum permitted number: 80
7. Fire fighting equipment: one 6-litre foam-type extinguisher behind the bar and one 2-kg CO<sub>2</sub>-type extinguisher, adjacent to the disco / karaoke equipment.
8. Exit doors: 2
9. Fire stewards: 1

### **05/m/58 PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT LICENCE –TRINITY STREET VAULTS**

The applicant was present.

The Head of Environmental Services (HES) presented the report.

The Fire Officer pointed out the lack of control on the people going in and out of the premises at a time. In response to this, the applicant stated that although the premises had a capacity for 200 people, his application was for 100 and the numbers of customers in future be monitored by a steward.

### **Resolved**

Approve subject to the following conditions:

1. Events may be held between 10.00 p.m. and 1.00 a.m., Mondays – Saturdays
2. Doors and windows shall be kept closed during events.
3. A noise limiter, set to the satisfaction of HES, and properly maintained, shall be used to control the volume of music and DJ announcements during events.
4. Maximum numbers in audience: 100
5. Number of exits: 2
6. Fire fighting equipment: 1 x 6 litre AFFF and 1 x 2kg CO<sub>2</sub> extinguishers
7. Fire Stewards: One
