Consideration of the Inclusion of Mill Road as a Third Area of the City within the a
Cumulative Impact Policy**

The Licensing Officer introduced the report and outlined the consultation process.

Councillor Boyce asked if the introduction of the Cumulative Impact Policy had had any noticeable impact on applications. The Licensing officer could not supply detailed information without prior notice.

Councillor Benstead asked for clarity on the position on using the policy retrospectively. The Solicitor stated that this would only be a factor for existing Licenses in the case of a review or a variation.

Councillor Rosenstiel felt that there was some ambiguity about the area the proposed extension would cover and asked if it was necessary to include the far end of Mill Road in the suggested zone. The Police and Licensing Officer replied that the area had been defined as the entire length of Mill Road (Excluding Brookfields) as this avoided confusion and took in the key locations where anti social behaviour had been a problem in the past.

Resolved (Unanimously)

To recommend to Full Council to approve the Statement of Licensing Policy with the following revisions.

- 1) To adopt the entire length of Mill Road (excluding Brookfields) as a third area within the special policy on Cumulative Impact within the statement on licensing policy.
- 2) The insertion of the following wording
 - A. To the special policy on Cumulative effect:
(changes Highlighted in bold)
Within the city centre marked on the map at Appendix 1
At the Cambridge Leisure site marked on the map at Appendix 2.
**With effect from 22 May 2008 the entire length of Mill Road Cambridge
(excluding Brookfields)**
 - B. Effective Date and Review
 - 12.1 This policy statement **took** effect on 7th January 2008 and **was amended with effect from 22 May 2008 to add Mill Road to the special policy on cumulative impact.**
 - 12.2 The policy statement will be kept under review and will remain in existence for a period of up to 3 years. It will be subject to review and further consultation before 7th January 2011.
