This order is made by Cambridge City Council and Cambridgeshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers. Cambridgeshire County Council makes this Order in respect of the Park and Ride parking places referred to in Part 7 of this Order and in respect of the Coach parking places referred to in Part 8 of this Order. Cambridge City Council makes this Order in respect of all other parking places referred to in this Order. Cambridge City Council makes this Order with the consent of Cambridgeshire County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the 1984 Act. The Chief Officer of Police has been consulted about this Order in accordance with paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act.

**PART 1      GENERAL**

**Commencement and citation**

- 1.1 This Order shall come into operation for all purposes on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 2008 and may be cited as The City of Cambridge (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2008.

**INTERPRETATION**

**Definitions**

- 1.2 In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meaning as hereby respectively assigned to them:

“The Act of 1984” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended);

“The Act of 2004” means the Traffic Management Act 2004 (as amended);

“Brunswick Resident Parking Permit Holder” means a person who is in possession of a valid Resident Parking Permit issued for Resident Parking Zone B – Brunswick;

“Bus” and “Buses” mean Motor Vehicles constructed or adapted to carry more than 8 passengers (exclusive of the Driver);

“Business Premises” means premises which are put to any of the following lawful planning use classes specified in the Schedule to the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987:

- Class A1 Shops
- Class A2 Financial and professional services
- Class B1 Business
- Class C1 Hotels and hostels

- Class D2 Assembly and leisure

subject to such limitations on the uses permitted within the same class as may be specified in part IV of the said First Schedule;

“Car” means any mechanically propelled Vehicle with more than two wheels except commercial Vehicles and Public Service Vehicles and includes a motorcycle with sidecar;

“Car Club” means a formally constituted car-sharing scheme approved of by the Council to operate within its boundaries

“Car Club Parking Permit” means a permit issued under the provisions of Article 2.28 of this Order

“Car Club Permit Holder” means a person or organisation to which a car club permit has been issued

“Car Club Parking Place” means an area of off-street Parking Place designated as such by this Order;

“Car Park Attendant” means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise any Parking Place;

“Charging Hours” means any period specified in Schedule 2 in respect of which a charge for Parking is specified;

“Civil Enforcement Officer” means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to enforce the regulations in any Parking Place;

Coaches” mean Motor Vehicles constructed or adapted to carry more than 8 passengers (exclusive of the Driver);

“Coach Parking Place” means a Parking Place designated as such by this Order;

“Controlled Hours” means the days and hours prescribed in this Order during which a Vehicle may Park in a Petersfield Resident Parking Place in accordance with the conditions in this Order;

“Council” means Cambridgeshire County Council in respect of the Park and Ride parking places referred to in Part 7 of this Order and in respect of the Coach parking places referred to in Part 8 of this Order and Cambridge City Council in respect of all other parking places referred to in this Order.;

“Disabled Person’s Badge” has the same meaning as stated in Regulation 3 of the Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons)(England) Regulations 2000 (Statutory Instrument 2000 No 683);

“Disabled Person’s Vehicle” means a vehicle displaying in the relevant position a disabled person’s badge in accordance with Part III of The Disabled Persons

(Badges for Motor Vehicles)(England) Regulations 2000 (Statutory Instrument 2000 No. 682) (as amended)

“Driver” means, in relation to a Vehicle Waiting in a Parking Place, the person who drove the Vehicle into the Parking Place and/or the person who with the Owner or Principal User’s authority removes it from the Parking Place;

“Excursion or Tour” is as defined in the Transport Act 1985;

“Express Carriage Service” is as defined in the Transport Act 1985 and means any service for the carriage of passengers for hire or reward at separate fares which is not a Local Service;

“Free Off-Street Parking Place” means a Parking Place designated as such by this Order;

“Goods Vehicle” means a Motor Vehicle which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods of any description, and is not drawing a trailer;

“Hackney Carriage” means a Vehicle defined in Section 33 of the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971 and duly licensed by the Council pursuant to its powers under Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1857 as amended by Section 16 of the Transport Act 1985;

“Invalid Carriage” has the same meaning as defined in Section 136(5) of The Act of 1984;

“Kite Resident Parking Permit Holder” means a person who is in possession of a valid Resident Parking Permit issued for Resident Parking Zone K – Kite;

“Local Bus” means a Public Service Vehicle used for the provision of a Local Service not being an Excursion or Tour;

“Local Service” is as defined in the Transport Act 1985;

“Maximum Time Limit” refers to a limit on the time that a Vehicle may under this Order Wait in a Parking Place;

“Motor Cycle” has the same meaning as defined in Section 136(5) of The Act of 1984;

“Motor Cycle Parking Place” means an area of off-street Parking Place designated as such by this Order

“Motor Vehicle” has the same meaning as stated in Sections 136(1) and 140 of The Act of 1984;

“Owner” means the person in whose name a Vehicle is registered at the relevant time under the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994;

“Park” refers to a Vehicle which Waits in a Parking Place in accordance with this Order;

“Parking” has a corresponding meaning to “Park”;

“Park And Ride Parking Place” means a Parking Place designated as such by this Order;

“Park And Ride Parking Place Site Co-ordinator” means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise and enforce regulations in a Park And Ride Parking Place;

“Parking Bay” means any area of a Parking Place which is provided for the leaving of a Vehicle and indicated by markings on the surface of the Parking Place;

“Parking Place” means jointly and severally as the context requires the following Parking Places designated by this Order

- Free Off-Street Parking Places,
- Pay And Display Parking Places,
- Pay On Exit Parking Places,
- Pay On Foot Parking Places,
- Park And Ride Parking Places,
- Coach Parking Places,
- Petersfield Resident Parking Places and
- Car Club Parking Places;
- Motor Cycle Parking Places

“Pay And Display Parking Place” means a Parking Place designated as such by this Order;

“Pay On Exit Parking Place” means a Parking Place designated as such by this Order;

“Pay On Foot Parking Place” means a Parking Place designated as such by this Order;

“Penalty Charge” means the charge set by the Council under the provisions of the ‘Act of 2004’;

“Permitted Parking Hours” means the days and hours prescribed in Schedule 1 Part 5 and Schedule 1 Part 6 during which a Vehicle may in accordance with the conditions in this Order Park in a Park And Ride Parking Place or a Coach Parking Place respectively;

“Petersfield Resident Parking Permit” means a Resident Parking Permit issued for Resident Parking Zone H – Petersfield;

“Petersfield Resident Parking Permit Holder” means a person who is in possession of a valid Petersfield Resident Parking;

“Petersfield Resident Parking Place” means an area of off-street Parking Place designated as such by this Order;

“Petersfield Visitor Parking Permit Holder” means a person who is in possession of a valid Visitor Parking Permit issued for Resident Parking Zone H – Petersfield;

“Principal User” means the person who, not being the Owner, is the person who is the main user of the Vehicle whether or not with the consent of the Owner;

“Private Hire Car” means a Vehicle being a Motor Vehicle constructed or adapted to carry fewer than 8 passengers other than a Hackney Carriage and duly licensed pursuant to Section 48 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;

“Private Motor Vehicle” means any Vehicle which is not a Public Service Vehicle or a Goods Vehicle or a Hackney Carriage as defined in Section 38 of the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971;

“Proprietor” means a person, partnership, company or organisation who occupy Business Premises situate within the boundary of the City of Cambridge;

“Public Service Vehicle” means a Vehicle adapted to carry at least 8 passengers not being a Hackney Carriage or a Private Hire Car;

“Relevant Position” means

- (i) in the case of a Vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the ticket, Season Tickets, badge or permit is exhibited thereon either on the nearside of and immediately behind the windscreen and with its front facing forward so as to be legible from the outside of the Vehicle, or on the dashboard or fascia panel so that the permit is legible from outside the Vehicle;
- (ii) in the case of a Vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, dashboard or fascia panel, the ticket, Season Tickets, badge or permit is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the Vehicle so that the permit is legible from outside the Vehicle;

“Resident Parking Permit” means a permit issued in accordance with the terms and conditions of the City of Cambridge (Civil Enforcement Area)(Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2008

“Resident Parking Permit Holder” means a person who holds a valid Resident Parking Permit;

“Season Ticket” means a ticket referred to in Article 2.4 to 2.6;

“School Bus” is as defined in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994

“Ticket” means a ticket purchased from a Ticket Machine at a Pay And Display Parking Place or a ticket obtained from the ticket dispensing apparatus at a Pay On Exit Parking Place entrance barrier or a Pay On Foot Parking Place entrance barrier, as the case may be.

“Ticket Machine”:

(a) ordinarily means an apparatus of a type and design approved by the Secretary of State for the purpose of this Order being apparatus designed to issue a ticket indicating the payment of charge, and the date and time at which a charge was paid, but

(b) where every Ticket Machine at a Parking Place is out of order or where the Parking Place is one designated as having a Ticket Machine but none is installed, references to Ticket Machine shall at the relevant time be construed to refer to the Car Park Attendant at the Parking Place from whom a ticket may be purchased;

“Vehicle” means a Motor Vehicle as defined in this Order;

“Visitor Parking Permit” means a Visitor Parking Permit issued in accordance with the terms and conditions of the The City of Cambridge (Permitted Parking and Special Parking Area)(Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places)(Consolidation) Order 2004;

“Wait” refers to a Vehicle stopping and remaining stationary for any period of time whether or not with the intention of Parking and a Vehicle shall be deemed to Wait for any period in the same Parking Place or Parking Bay (as the case may be) if any part of it is below the Vehicle or the Vehicle’s load (if any) whether or not the Vehicle is moved during that period;

“Waiting” has a corresponding meaning to “Wait”.

## **Interpretation**

- 1.3 Except where the context requires otherwise, any reference in this order to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
- 1.4 The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 1.5 “Include”, “includes” and “including” are deemed to be followed by the words “without limitation” and general words introduced by “other” do not have a restrictive meaning, and “for example” is not to be interpreted as if there are not other examples nor to limit or restrict the ordinary meaning of the words preceding it.
- 1.6 Headings are for convenience only and do not affect the construction of this Order.

- 1.7 A provision of this Order which is void or unenforceable shall (to that extent) be read down so as to be valid and enforceable and if it is not capable of being so read down then it shall be severed from all other provisions of this Order and the remaining provisions shall continue to have effect.
- 1.8 Words importing the singular or plural number include the plural and singular number respectively and words importing the masculine gender include the feminine or neutral gender and references to a person or corporation include a corporation or person respectively.

## **PART 2 GENERAL PROVISIONS**

### **Use of Parking Places**

- 2.1 Each Parking Place may only be used according to the terms specified for it in this Order including the class of Vehicle, the positioning of the Vehicle, the Maximum Time Limit for Waiting and the days and times permitted or prohibited and on payment of the charges payable.

### **Manner of Standing**

- 2.2 Every Vehicle left Waiting in a Parking Place in accordance with the provisions of this Order shall stand so that every part of the Vehicle is within the limits of a particular Parking Bay within the limits of the Parking Place

### **Reduction of charges for Disabled Person's Badge Holders**

- 2.3 Any disabled person's Vehicle which displays in the Relevant Position a disabled persons badge Parking may be charged a reduced Parking charge to the extent specified in Schedule 2 in respect of the Parking Place in which the Vehicle is Waiting.

### **Application for Season Tickets**

- 2.4 By lodging a completed prescribed application form and tendering the prescribed fee:
- (a) a Proprietor of any Business Premises located within the Council's boundaries may make application to the Council for a Season Ticket in respect of a Vehicle owned by that Proprietor or an employee to Park in a Parking Place for which this Order permits Season Tickets PROVIDED THAT only a Proprietor of Business Premises located at an address specified in Schedule 3 is eligible to apply to Park in Grafton Centre East Parking Place,
  - (b) Brunswick Resident Parking Permit Holders and Kite Resident Parking Permit Holders may make application to the Council for a Season Ticket to permit the Vehicles for which their Resident Parking Permits were issued to also Park in the Grafton Centre West Car Park between the hours of 6:30pm and 8:30am Monday to Saturday (both inclusive) and all hours on Sundays.

### **Issue of Season Ticket**

- 2.5 On receipt of a correctly completed application in the prescribed form with the prescribed fee and provided that the applicant has satisfied all criteria the Council may issue a Season Ticket for the nominated Vehicle of an eligible applicant under Article 2.4 on such terms as the Council may from time to time determine.

### **Season Ticket terms enforceable under this Order**

- 2.6 The terms of the Season Tickets must be observed as if they were terms in this Order applying to the Parking Place in respect of which the Vehicle is Waiting and failure to observe such terms is deemed to be a breach of this Order.

### **Time Limits**

- 2.7 A Driver shall not allow a Vehicle to Wait in a Parking Place as specified in Schedule 2 beyond the Maximum Time Limit specified in Schedule 2 nor for longer than the time or period stated on any Ticket or Season Ticket or Car Club Parking Permit or Visitor Parking Permit issued to the Driver.

### **Parking only for Disabled Person's Badge Holders**

- 2.8 A Driver shall not cause or permit a Vehicle to Wait in a Parking Bay marked for a Disabled Person's Vehicle unless that Driver is either a disabled Driver or a Driver accompanying a disabled person and the Vehicle displays a valid Disabled Person's Badge in the manner prescribed by Regulation 12 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles)(England) Regulations 2000.

### **Compliance with entry and exit signs and markings**

- 2.9 A Driver shall comply with all signs and markings in a Parking Place:
- (a) indicating the entrance to or exit from the Parking Place; or
  - (b) indicating that a Vehicle using the Parking Place shall proceed in a specified direction within the Parking Place.

### **Prohibition against obstructions**

- 2.10 The Driver of a Vehicle using a Parking Place shall not obstruct access to the Parking Place or to any premises adjoining the Parking Place or obstruct the access roads within the Parking Place.

### **Stop engine in Parking Place**

- 2.11 The Driver of a Motor Vehicle using a Parking Place shall stop the engine as soon as a Vehicle is correctly in the position in the Parking Place and shall not subsequently start the engine except when about to change the position of the Vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place.

### **Sounding horns**

- 2.12 The Driver of a Vehicle using a Parking Place shall not sound or permit any other person to sound any horn or any similar instrument except when necessary while Parking his Vehicle in the Parking Place or when about to change the position of the Vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place.

### **No through access**

- 2.13 No person shall use a Parking Place as a means of passage from one road to another road.

### **Further Restrictions on use of a Parking Place**

- 2.14 It is prohibited without the written consent of the Director of City Services of the Council or his nominee for anyone to use a Parking Place or to use or allow to be so used any Vehicle left in a Parking Place:
- (a) to undertake (or allow to be undertaken) any cleaning, maintenance or repair of a Vehicle except such as may be necessary to enable the Vehicle to be removed from the Parking Place;
  - (b) for or in connection with the sale of any goods or services to anyone in or near the Parking Place;
  - (c) for sleeping or accommodation or camping purposes;
  - (d) for eating or cooking purposes; or
  - (e) to use a Vehicle or allowing it to be used for any purpose other than the temporary leaving of the Vehicle.

### **Licensing and insurance of Vehicles**

- 2.15 The Driver of a Vehicle shall not cause nor permit that Vehicle to Wait in any Parking Place unless the Vehicle is licensed in accordance with the provision of Section 1 of the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971 and a policy of insurance complying with the requirements of Part VI of the Road Traffic Act 1972 is current in respect of the use of the Vehicle by that Driver.

### **Deposit of litter**

- 2.16 Littering of a Parking Place is prohibited.

### **Disturbances**

- 2.17 Causing or permitting to cause a disturbance or annoyance or nuisance to users of the Parking Place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood is prohibited.

### **Threatening or abusive behaviour**

- 2.18 Use of any threatening abusive or insulting language gesture or conduct in a Parking Place intended to or likely to cause offence or fear to any person or so as to occasion a breach of the peace is prohibited.

### **Prohibition of structures and fires**

- 2.19 In a Parking Place no person shall:
- (a) erect or cause to be erected any tent stand building or other structure without the written consent of the Council; or
  - (b) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire.

### **Removal and repositioning of Vehicles**

- 2.20 When a Vehicle Waits in a Parking Place in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the Vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that Parking Place and when a Vehicle is Waiting in a Parking Place in contravention of the provision of Article 2.2 a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the Vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.

### **Removal of Vehicles in an emergency**

- 2.21 For the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency a person authorised in that behalf by the Council or a police constable in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of a Vehicle in a Parking Place or remove or arrange for the removal of a Vehicle from a Parking Place and in so doing shall provide for the safe custody of the Vehicle.

### **Method of removing and repositioning Vehicles**

- 2.22 A person authorised to remove or alter the position of a Vehicle in Articles 2.20 or 2.21 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the Vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the Vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position as the case may be.

### **Safe custody of Vehicles**

- 2.23 When a person authorised by the Council to remove a Vehicle either removes or makes arrangements for its removal under this Order he/she shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the Vehicle.

### **Power to close any Parking Place or part thereof**

- 2.24 Notwithstanding the provisions of this Order any person authorised by the Council may by notice displayed on or near the Parking Place close any Parking Place or any part thereof for any period and may designate it or any part as reserved for use only by particular Vehicles for particular purposes approved by the Council.

- 2.25 No Driver of any Vehicle shall use the Parking Place or any part thereof when it is so closed unless with the written consent of the Council or in compliance with the particulars of reservation.

**No liability for loss or damage to Vehicle or property**

- 2.26 Vehicles using the Parking Places do so at the risk of the Driver and the Council accepts no liability or responsibility either at common law or under the Occupiers' Liability Act 1957 or otherwise for loss of or damage to Vehicles or other property left in Parking Places.

**Tickets as evidence**

- 2.27 The particulars specified on a Ticket as to the time at which a Ticket was obtained from the Ticket Machine or at an entry barrier shall (in the absence of proof of the malfunction of the Ticket Machine or the automatic barrier) be conclusive proof of the particulars so specified.

**Application for Car Club Parking Permit**

- 2.28 By lodging a completed prescribed application form and tendering the prescribed fee a Car Club Operator may make application to the Council for a Car Club Parking Permit in respect of a Vehicle owned or used by that Operator to Park in a Parking Place for which this Order permits Car Club Parking Permits

**Issue of Car Club Parking Permit**

- 2.29 On receipt of a correctly completed application in the prescribed form with the prescribed fee and provided that the applicant has satisfied all criteria the Council may issue a Car Club Parking Permit for the nominated Vehicle of an eligible applicant under Article 2.28 on such terms as the Council may from time to time determine.

**Car Club Parking Permit terms enforceable under this Order**

- 2.30 The terms of the Car Club Parking Permits must be observed as if they were terms in this Order applying to the Parking Place in respect of which the Vehicle is Waiting and failure to observe such terms is deemed to be a breach of this Order.

**Parking only for Car Club Permit Holders**

- 2.31 Each Car Club Parking Place may only be used in accordance with this Order for Waiting by Vehicles displaying in the Relevant Position a valid Car Club Parking Permit issued in respect of that Vehicle relating to that Parking Place

**Parking Only for Motorcycles**

- 2.32 A Driver shall not cause or permit a Motor Vehicle other than a Motor Cycle to Wait in a Parking Bay marked as a Motor Cycle Parking Place

## **PART 3 PAY ON FOOT PARKING PLACES**

### **Designation of Pay On Foot Parking Places**

- 3.1 The Parking Places specified in Schedule 1 Part 1 to this Order are hereby designated as Pay On Foot Parking Places and are subject to the provisions of this Order.

### **Use of Pay On Foot Parking Places**

- 3.2 Pay On Foot Parking Places are controlled by entry and exit barriers whereby the Driver of a Vehicle gains entry to such Parking Places by taking a Ticket at the entry barrier. This Ticket shall be submitted to a pay station at the end of the Parking period and validated by making payment in accordance with the Parking charges shown respectively for the said Parking Places in Schedule 2 Part 1. The validated Ticket shall then be used to operate the exit barrier.
- 3.3 In the event that a Driver of a Vehicle is unable to produce a ticket through loss or any other cause whatsoever he/she may obtain a validated ticket by applying to a Car Park Attendant and making a payment at a pay station at a rate which assumes that the Vehicle has been in the Parking Place since 9.00am on the day in question.

### **Use of Season Tickets or Car Club Parking Permits for Pay On Foot Parking Places**

- 3.4 The Driver of a Vehicle Waiting in accordance with the provisions of this Order shall be exempt from payment of a daily Parking charge if a valid Season Ticket or a Car Club Parking Permit for that Vehicle is used to gain access through the entry and exit barriers for a Pay On Foot Parking Place to which the Season Ticket or Car Club Parking Permit applies.
- 3.5 The Waiting of a Vehicle in and departure from a Pay On Foot Parking Place other than in accordance with this Part is prohibited.

## **PART 4      PAY ON EXIT PARKING PLACES**

### **Designation of Pay On Exit Parking Places**

- 4.1      The Parking Places specified in Schedule 1 Part 2 are hereby designated as Pay On Exit Parking Places and are subject to the provisions of this Order.

### **Use of Pay On Exit Parking Places**

- 4.2      Pay On Exit Parking Places are controlled by entry and exit barriers and/or staff to collect payment of the Parking charge whereby the Driver of a Vehicle gains entry by taking a ticket at the entry barrier. This ticket shall be submitted to the Car Park Attendant controlling the Parking Place or the payment machine at the exit barrier when the Vehicle leaves the Parking Place and appropriate payment made in accordance with the Parking charges specified in Schedule 2 Part 2.
- 4.3      In the event that a Driver of a Vehicle is unable to produce a ticket through loss or any other cause whatsoever he/she may obtain exit by making a payment at the exit barrier at a rate which assumes that the Vehicle has been in the Parking Place since 9.00am on the day in question.
- 4.4      The Waiting of a Vehicle in and departure from a Pay On Exit Parking Place other than in accordance with this Part is prohibited.

## **PART 5 PAY AND DISPLAY PARKING PLACES**

### **Designation of Pay And Display Parking Places**

- 5.1 The Parking Places specified in Schedule 1 Part 3 are hereby designated Pay And Display Parking Places and are subject to the provisions of this Order.

### **Use of Pay And Display Parking Places**

- 5.2 The Driver of a Vehicle shall not permit it to Wait during the Charging Hours in a Pay And Display Parking Place longer than the Maximum Time Limit (if any) specified in Schedule 2 Part 3 in relation to that Parking Place and shall not return to any part of the same Parking Place until at least 1 hour has passed since the end of its last use irrespective of whether or not it is the same Parking Bay.

### **Valid Ticket required**

- 5.3 A Driver of a Vehicle Waiting in a Pay And Display Parking Place must have a valid Ticket for the whole time that the Vehicle is Waiting during the Charging Hours. A Ticket used in a Pay And Display Parking Place shall only be valid if:
- (a) it has been purchased at or before the time the Vehicle commenced Waiting from a Ticket Machine in the Parking Place where the Vehicle is Waiting;
  - (b) it is exhibited on the Vehicle in the Relevant Position

### **Exceptions to payment of daily charge**

- 5.4 The Driver of a Vehicle Waiting in accordance with the provisions of this Order during the Charging Hours in a Pay And Display Parking Place where Season Tickets are allowed as indicated in Schedule 2 Part 3 shall be exempt from purchasing a Ticket if a valid Season Ticket applicable to the Vehicle and the Parking Place is displayed in the Relevant Position at all times while the Vehicle is Waiting.
- 5.5 The Driver of a Vehicle Waiting in accordance with the provisions of this Order during the Charging Hours in a Pay And Display Parking Place where Car Club Parking Permits are allowed as indicated in Schedule 2 Part 3 shall be exempt from purchasing a Ticket if a valid Car Club Parking Permit applicable to the Vehicle and the Parking Place is displayed in the Relevant Position at all times while the Vehicle is Waiting in a Parking Bay marked for a Car Club Permit Holders Vehicle.
- 5.6 Where all the Ticket Machines at the said Parking Place carry notices placed upon them by a person duly authorised by the Council indicating that they are out of order and no Car Park Attendant is in attendance at the Parking Place the Driver of a Vehicle shall be exempt from the payment of the charge; PROVIDED THAT the Vehicle does not remain in the Parking Place for longer than the Maximum Time Limit (if any) allowed in the Parking Place.

**Restriction on removal of Ticket or Season Tickets or Car Club Parking Permits**

- 5.7 No one other than the Driver of the Vehicle or a person authorised by the Council shall remove a Pay And Display Parking Place Ticket or Season Ticket or Car Club Parking Permit from a Vehicle unless authorised to do so by the Driver.
- 5.8 The Waiting of a Vehicle in a Pay And Display Parking Place other than in accordance with this Part is prohibited.

## **PART 6      PETERSFIELD RESIDENT PARKING PLACES**

### **Designation of Petersfield Resident Parking Places**

- 6.1 Each Parking Place which is described in Schedule 1 Part 4 is hereby designated as a Petersfield Resident Parking Place and are subject to the provisions of this Order.

### **Times of operation of Petersfield Resident Parking Places**

- 6.2 Each Resident Parking Place specified in Schedule 1 Part 4 may be used for Parking during its Controlled Hours only by such Vehicles as are displaying in the Relevant Position a valid Petersfield Resident Parking Permit issued in respect of that Vehicle.

### **Restriction on the removal of Resident Parking Permit**

- 6.3 Where a Resident Parking Permit has been displayed on a Vehicle no person other than the Driver of the Vehicle or a person authorised by the Council shall remove the permit from the Vehicle unless authorised to do so by the Driver of the Vehicle.

### **Exemptions for Disabled Person's Vehicles**

- 6.4 The failure to possess or display a Resident Parking Permit shall not prohibit any Disabled Person's Vehicle displaying a valid disabled person' badge in the Relevant Position from Waiting during the Controlled Hours in any Resident Parking Place.
- 6.5 The Waiting of a Vehicle in a Resident Parking Place other than in accordance with this Part is prohibited.

## **PART 7      PARK AND RIDE PARKING PLACES**

### **Designation of Park And Ride Parking Places**

- 7.1 The Parking Places specified in Schedule 1 Part 5 are hereby designated as Park And Ride Parking Places for the classes of Vehicles and are subject to the terms of this Order.

### **Payment of charge**

- 7.2 The Driver of a Vehicle Waiting in a Park And Ride Parking Place shall pay the appropriate charge in accordance with the scale of charges as specified in Schedule 2 Part 5.

### **Permitted Parking Hours and Maximum Time Limit**

- 7.3 The Driver of a Vehicle shall not permit it to Wait in a Park And Ride Parking Place for any period outside the Permitted Parking Hours or for longer than the Maximum Time Limit specified in Schedule 2 Part 5 in relation to that Parking Place.

### **Passenger Pick-up and Set-down Only**

- 7.4 With the exception of Waiting whilst picking-up or setting-down passengers during the Permitted Parking Hours, a Vehicle operating an Express Carriage Service shall not enter a Park And Ride Parking Place nor Wait in a Park And Ride Parking Place between service runs.

### **Prohibition**

- 7.5 The Waiting of a Vehicle in a Park And Ride Parking Place other than in accordance with this Part is prohibited.

## **PART 8 COACH PARKING PLACES**

### **Designation of Coach Parking Places**

- 8.1 The Parking Places specified in Schedule 1 Part 6 are hereby designated as Coach Parking Places and are subject to the terms of this Order.

### **Use of Coach Parking Places**

- 8.2 No Vehicle shall Wait in a Coach Parking Place unless it is a Coach or a Bus and:
- (a) it is Waiting within the Permitted Parking Hours of the Coach Parking Place,
  - (b) the Driver has paid the charge specified in Schedule 2 Part 6 for the time it is Waiting,
  - (c) the Driver is displaying in the Relevant Position the receipt for the charge paid and
  - (d) the Maximum Time Limit specified in Schedule 2 Part 6 is not exceeded and
  - (e) the Bus or Coach is being used for either an Excursion or Tour or as a School Bus.

### **Payment Procedure**

- 8.3 The Driver of a Coach or Bus using a Coach Parking Place shall pay the appropriate charge in accordance with the scale of charges as specified in Schedule 2 Part 6 to the Park And Ride Parking Place Site Co-ordinator. The Park And Ride Parking Place Site Co-ordinator shall issue to the Driver a receipt for payment of the charge.

### **Prohibition**

- 8.4 The Waiting of a Vehicle in a Coach Parking Place other than in accordance with this Part is prohibited.

## **PART 9 FREE PARKING PLACES**

### **Designation**

- 9.1 Each Parking Place which is described in Schedule 1 Part 7 is hereby designated as a Free Parking Place and is subject to the terms of this Order.

### **Use of Free Parking Places**

- 9.2 Use of Free Parking Places other than for Parking of Vehicles of the class referred to in Schedule 1 Part 7 is prohibited.
- 9.3 Nothing in Article 9.2 above shall prohibit a Car Club Permit Holders Vehicle from Parking in a Parking Bay marked for Car Club Permit Holders.

## **PART 10    CONTRAVENTION OF THIS ORDER**

### **CONTRAVENTION**

- 10.1 Where a contravention of this order constitutes a parking contravention within the meaning of The Act of 2004, or successor legislation, the contravention shall be subject to the penalties and procedures provided for by that legislation.
- 10.2 Where a contravention of this order constitutes a parking contravention within the meaning of The Act of 2004 a Penalty Charge is payable for each calendar day or part thereof that the Vehicle is in contravention of this Order by the Owner and the Vehicle may be removed by or on behalf of the Council in accordance with the the provisions of the Act of 2004 and of this Order.
- 10.3 A contravention of this order which does not constitute a parking contravention within the meaning of The Act of 2004, or successor legislation, is an offence under section 35A(1) of the 1984 Act.

### **REMOVAL OF VEHICLES**

- 10.4 Where a Civil Enforcement Officer has removed or caused to be removed a Vehicle in accordance with Article 10.2
- (a) he/she shall provide for the safe custody of the Vehicle;
  - (b) the Council shall be entitled to recover from the Owner or the person responsible such charges as provided by the Act of 2004 in respect of the removal, storage and disposal of the Vehicle
  - (c) the provisions of the 1984 Act as amended shall apply to the disposal of such Vehicles removed by or on behalf of the Council pursuant to this Article.
