Adoption Statement

Cambridge Local Development Framework Public Art Supplementary Planning Document

(Regulation 16(2) and 19 of the Town and Country planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004)

Cambridge City Council adopted the Public Art Supplementary Planning Document on 12th January 2010. Any person aggrieved by the Public Art Supplementary Planning Document may make an application to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Document. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the Supplementary Planning Document was adopted.

Title of Document: Public Art Supplementary Planning Document (SPD).

Subject Matter: The Public Art SPD provides further guidance on the application of the City Council's public art policy.

Area of Document: The SPD applies to the whole area of Cambridge.
