

## **PRESCRIBED EDUCATIONAL ESTABLISHMENTS**

### **ESTABLISHMENTS FOR STUDENTS**

1. Subject to paragraph (3) below, an institution is a prescribed educational establishment within this Part if it is -

(a) Situated in a Member State, and

(b) Established solely or mainly for the purpose of providing further or higher education.

1. In this Part -

“Further education”, in relation to a Member State, means -

(a) Any course of education (other than a course which is within the definition of “higher education” below) which is suitable to the requirements of persons who are over compulsory school age applicable in that state, and

(b) Organised leisure-time occupation provided in connection with such a course; “higher education”, in relation to a member state, means any course of education the successful completion of which results in any of the following qualifications -

a. A first degree,

b. A higher degree,

c. A qualification (including a professional qualification) which is regarded by the relevant authority as being equivalent to a qualification (or part of a qualification) mentioned in paragraph (a) or (b) of this definition; and “relevant authority”, in relation to a member state, means the authority which in relation to that state has sole or primary responsibility for the regulation of higher education”.

**3.**

A Ministry of Defence training establishment for the armed forces is not a prescribed educational establishment within this Part of this Schedule.

**STUDENT SPOUSE:**

A non-British spouse or dependent of a full-time student qualifies for a discount if they:

- Are not a British citizen and
- Prevented by immigration regulations from taking paid employment or from claiming benefits.
