If possible, for each abstraction please could you supply: • Details of name, address and/or grid reference of each groundwater abstraction • What it is used for • Date of commencement of abstraction • The main aquifer unit the groundwater is abstracted from. My request refers to private groundwater supplies that do not need an abstraction licence from the Environment Agency e.g. a supply of drinking water from a well.
