I was contacting you to see if you are able to send me vector GIS data relating to the local plan, such as SHLAA, allocated sites, development areas, conservation areas, contaminated land brownfield et al? If required, I am happy to anonymize information within the data, I only require areas for cost weighting and informing users of the potential intersection. Furthermore, I have licenses for OS Master map and Address base Premium which I can share if required.
