Response:

How many people do you commission for Supported Living placements:

'Supported Living' whereby individuals are supported to live independently in their home through extra help with personal care, administering medications, completing and reviewing care plans etc, is not provided or commissioned by Cambridge City Council. We currently have 36 Extra Care flats available within our Ditchburn Place Sheltered Accommodation, however, this service is managed separately by Radis Community Care and is commissioned by Cambridgeshire County Council. Cambridge City Council does have its own 'supported housing' services for tenants and residents, but this is very different to 'supported living placements' as no personal care element is provided. Our Tenancy Sustainment Service provides support to city council tenants aged 18 or over whose tenancy is (or could be) at risk due to mental health issues, local antisocial behaviour, a history of homelessness, or other complex support needs. The other is our Visiting Support Service, which is available for all Cambridge residents aged over 65, irrespective of what property they live in. The aim is to connect older people with services that help them remain independent and socially active. If you would like further information on the number of residents supported by these 2 services in 20/21 then I would be happy to provide details.
