

TREE WORKS NOTIFICATION

A brief outline of the proposed works can be found in the table below; however, full details can be found in the attached schedule and map. I refer you to Policy GM3 of the Cambridge City Council Citywide Tree Strategy 2016-2026 Part 2:

“All planned tree works will be published on the Council website and through site notices for the community to access at least 20 working days before implementation. The council sees this as an important tool for communicating to the local community about tree work planned for their area and the reasons why the works are necessary.”

The notification period will run for **20 days** from the date of publication of the schedule.

PERMIT TO WORK

Under POLICY SP1, the Council will consider applications from householders to alleviate problems on the basis that they will fund the works, that the works will be agreed with the Council beforehand (a 'Permit to Work'), that a suitable arboricultural contractor is appointed, and that each case will be considered on its individual merits.

The work proposed within this schedule is an application for a 'Permit to Work' and consists of pruning to reduce the obstruction of sunlight to solar panels by a Council-owned tree. Whilst the Tree Team has no objections to the work it is not an action we would undertake (POLICY: SP12 The Council will not prune or fell a council owned/managed tree to improve natural light to a solar panel).

NORWAY MAPLE ~ reduce lateral growth NORTH by 2.5ms, SOUTH and EAST by 3.5ms and WEST by 2.5ms, raise crown all round to 4ms and thin remaining crown by 15%, leaving crown shaped and balanced.

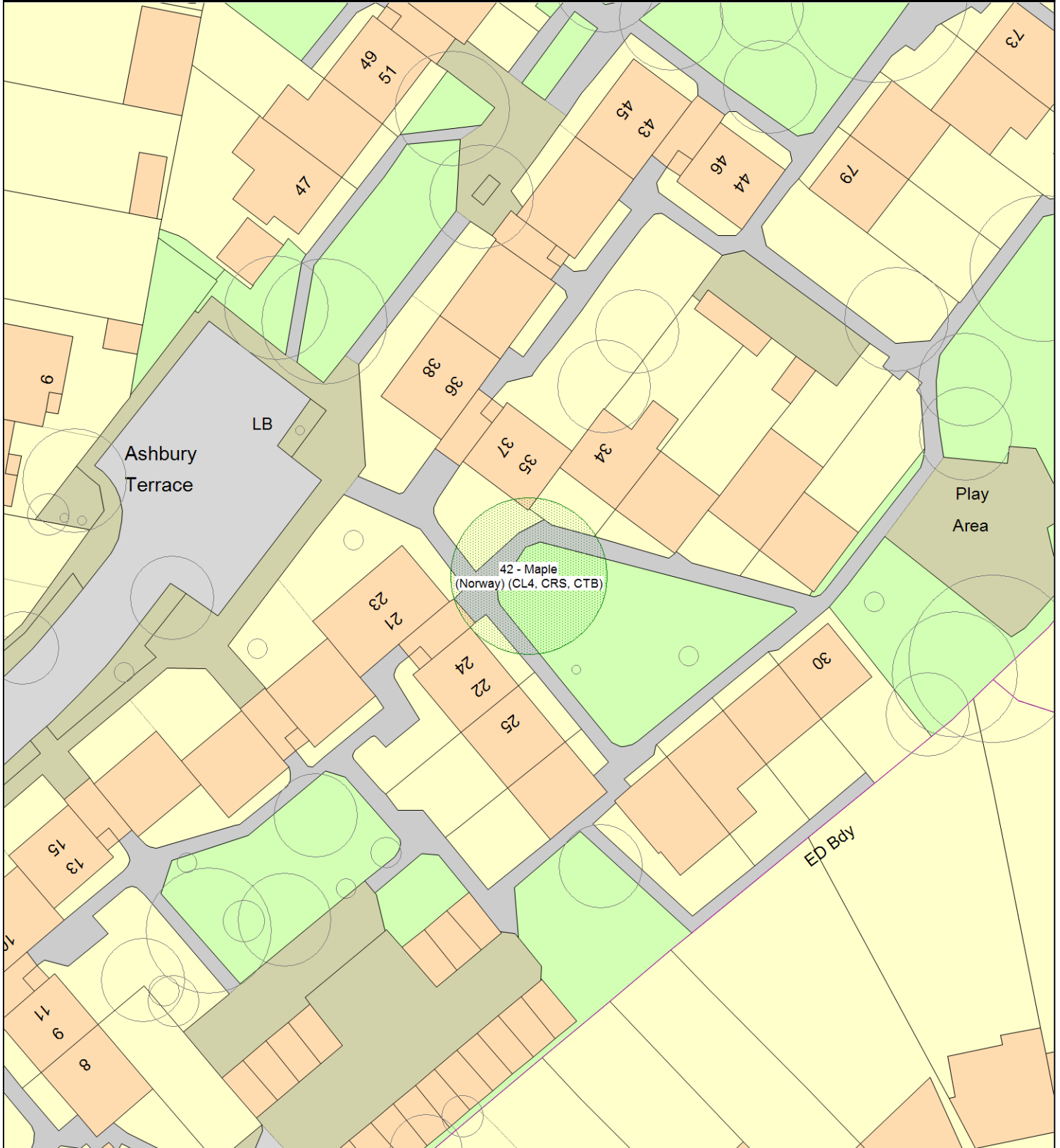
