

(CCC) Intermediate rent schemes

1. Does the council have an intermediate housing/rent scheme? Can you provide detail of the scheme
2. What is the subsidised rent you offer on these intermediate homes (is it 20% off market value for example?)
3. What are the benefits you offer if a person who has used the intermediate housing scheme then goes onto buying their own home? (For example, Westminster City Council runs its own intermediate rent scheme where it gives £2,000 in free cash for every year a tenant stays in its homes. The tenant is given this cash - as long as they go on to buy a shared ownership property.) Can you list each benefit you offer please
4. For each separate benefit listed for (3), can you provide details on how many people received each benefit broken down for the following years:
 - January 1 2018 - December 31 2018
 - January 1 2019 - December 31 2019
 - January 1 2020 - December 31 2020
 - January 1 2021 - September 1 2021(so like this: X people received Y benefit between January 1 2018-December 31 2018, and so on)
5. Could I get a breakdown of many people used the council's intermediate housing scheme for the following years:
 - January 1 2018 - December 31 2018
 - January 1 2019 - December 31 2019
 - January 1 2020 - December 31 2020
 - January 1 2021 - September 1 2021
6. Of the people who used the council's intermediate housing scheme detailed in (5), could you provide a breakdown of how many people went on to buy their own property for the following years:
 - January 1 2018 - December 31 2018
 - January 1 2019 - December 31 2019
 - January 1 2020 - December 31 2020
 - January 1 2021 - September 1 2021
