### **(CCC) Planning Application Documents**

I write further to reading the above cited Planning Application Documents as relate to work being carried out at Northstowe by Barratt David Wilson Homes.

In the above cited documents reference is made to the need to perform piling over a period of 4 - 5 weeks (I attach a screen shot copy of relevant text).

My request is that information be provided of the evidence submitted to your authority explaining why all alternative methods of foundation-setting are not to be used and that piling has been established as the only viable method.

### **Response**

I am writing in response to your freedom of information request for evidence submitted to the Council explaining why all alternative methods of foundation-setting are not to be used and that piling has been established as the only viable method.

The Council's Enforcement Team issued a Temporary Stop Notice requiring unauthorised piling to cease, which was complied with. Following this action, the attached correspondence was received from Barratt David Wilson regarding piling.
