5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 5 May 2022** between the hours of 7 am and 10 pm.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 11:59 pm on Thursday 14 April 2022. Applications can be made online at gov.uk/register-to-vote.
7. New applications to vote by post or the amendment or cancellation of an existing postal vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the correspondence address below by 5 pm on Tuesday 19 April 2022.
8. New applications to vote by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address below by 5 pm on Tuesday 26 April 2022. Amendments or cancellations to existing proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the correspondence address below by 5 pm on Tuesday 19 April 2022.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the correspondence address below by 5 pm on Thursday 5 May 2022.
