(CCC) Requests for ID from Members of the Public Attending Council Meetings

- * Any council policies covering the subject of asking members of the public seeking to observe council meetings in-person for identification.
- * Records of any decisions to ask members of the public seeking to observe council meetings in-person for identification, including any supporting materials.
- * Correspondence between councillors and officers, or between officers, on the subject of asking members of the public seeking to observe council meetings in-person for identification.
- * The instructions provided to those asking members of the public seeking to observe council meetings in-person for identification.
