**Response:**

Thank you for your request for information above, The Freedom of Information Act exists to allow access to publicly held information, to promote open, accountable local government and to develop increased trust in government by ensuring transparent ways of working. This enables understanding of how a public authority functions. Any request for the disclosure of information under FOI, must be considered to be made into the wider public domain.

To be classed as 'personal data' the information must be able to be attributed to an individual, and have the ability to identify an individual, this can include name and address, in other words it is detail that tells you something about somebody. We find that exemption s40(2) – personal data of third parties – applies and decline to respond further.
