How many licences has the council awarded to schools or charities to use sites not accessible to the public for educational needs / forest school activities since 2019 One in 2020. The permission for Highfields this year was done as a series of events, a copy of the Highfields licence is attached as requested.

Was a biodiversity audit carried out before the Highfield Tree Belt was designated for educational needs/forest school use? Yes. City Council Ecologist and Tree Officer visited site to assess habitats and trees, whilst no formal management plan drawn up to date one is currently being prepared.

what other information was provided before the Highfield Tree belt was designated for educational / forest school activities? Letter to residents dated 02/10/19 outlining intention to licence (attached). The trees on the land are plotted on Council tree management software and form part of a wider inspection/maintenance schedule.

Under what power was the change of use of the Highfield Tree Belt made? This is guided by the Council's constitution;
