Your RECYCLED FOOD WASTE is made into compost and sold to LOCAL FARMERS to plough back into the land





Why REDUCE your food waste?

The best thing we can do is use up the food and drink we buy. All the water, energy and packaging used in food production, transportation and storage are wasted when we don't. This all contributes to climate change.

The average UK family throws away **£60** worth of food every month! So it pays to spend a little time planning meals, storing food correctly and using up leftovers.

USE YOUR CADDY AND GREEN BIN TO COMPOST THE REST

Use your caddy for

- All uneaten food & plate scrapings
- Mouldy or out of date food
 inc. ready meals removed from their packaging
- Peelings
- ✓ Tea bags & coffee grounds
- ✓ Bread & pastries
- Jairy products (inc. egg shells)
- ✓ Rice, pasta & beans
- ✓ Meat, fish \$ bones (raw \$ cooked)

Do not include

- * Packaging of any kind
- × Liquids such as milk, oil or fat
- Compostable plastic 'bio' bags, cups, cutlery etc.

Top tip:

Compostable plastic 'bio' bags do not break down quickly enough in our fast composting process. Please don't use them.

Recycling your FOOD WASTE has never been easier

Collect a FREE kitchen caddy. We recommend lining it with newspaper or paper bag liners. Keep the caddy lid shut. 2

When it is full fold over the top of the liner and put it in your outdoor food and garden waste (green) bin. Put your green bin out for collection by 6:00am on your normal recycling day.







Have you got the right equipment?

To recycle food waste you must have an outdoor green wheelie bin, or be on a brown sack collection. Check the council website for your area below for locations where you can collect a free kitchen caddy or buy paper caddy liners.

Top tip:

You can collect free soil improver made from the contents of the green bins at the Amey Waste Management Park near Waterbeach.
