(CCC) Cambridge Park Street Aparthotel and Public Car / Cycle Park
Redevelopment

I hereby make a freedom of information request regarding the monitoring of vibrations, shock waves and similar conducted as part of the demolition works of the Park Street Car Park in central Cambridge. Gilbert Ash are required by Marick the developer, and the council as owner of the site, as part of the planning consent to conduct such monitoring. Such information should cover the entire period of demolition up to and including at least today's date, i.e. at least the entirety of March and April 2022. Information requested includes at a minimum:

1. Time and data stamped data logs from pre-agreed and any further ad-hoc monitoring stations
2. Reports on vibrations and shock waves prepared by subcontractors and submitted to Gilbert Ash or Marick
3. Internal progress reports and other correspondence that include summary reference and commentary on the subject
4. Information pertaining to residents' complaints about vibrations and the actions taken by the council and its contractors
5. For the avoidance of doubt, the dataset should include additional measurements taken further to specific complaints by
 - a. Residents of Portugal Place
 - b. Residents of The Old Vicarage CB5 8AQ

I can confirm that requests have been made to obtain information directly from the contractor, and from the council by the normal means as set out in the plans for ongoing community engagement, and none has been provided. It has been reported to me by residents of Portugal Place that similar attempts to release this information have not been satisfied.
