Thank you for your request for information above. The appropriate department are dealing with your request

under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 2000 and from their preliminary assessment they estimate

that to locate, retrieve and extract the information would exceed the 'appropriate limit' set for local government

at £450 which represents 18hrs of one staff member.

Section 12 of the FOI Act provides a refusal exemption on this basis. We invite you to refine your request, by specifying

the information you particularly wish to obtain, including any dates or period of time relevant to the information required,

as we would like to assist by attempting to provide you with some of the information required within the cost limit.

However, we have attached the 2021/2022 DHP return for DWP.

We do not hold any more specific data and to check each award would exceed the above limits. We have asked colleagues in Housing if there are any rent support schemes that may fit the description of rent support schemes. Their response is that we do not have a scheme that covers any unpaid rent or damagers. However, did 19 deposit bonds in 21/22 totaling £12,179.21. We do

not keep records of the background of the customers. We also have an Access

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Scheme where we pay first months' rent and deposit. We did 89 Access Scheme grants in 21/22 totaling £102,576.14. We do not keep records of people's backgrounds.

Alternatively, you may choose to pay the fee for work to be undertaken to answer your request. This charge will be calculated in accordance with section 13 of the FOI Act and the Freedom of Information Fees Regulations and is required prior to work commencing so please let us know and we will inform you of the fee.
