

**THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE (PUBLIC OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)
(AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2023**

Notice is hereby given that Cambridge City Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) (as amended) and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the Cambridgeshire County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (as amended) has made the above-named Order which comes into effect on 1 April 2023.

The effect of this Order is to amend the City of Cambridge (Public Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023 (the Order of 2023) as follows:

1. Substitute designated free car parks and parking places Schedule 2 Table 4 of the Consolidated Order of 2023 the revision of times of operation, maximum time limits and period of no return included on the table of Schedule 1 of this Order.
2. Substitute in Schedules 3 Table 1 and Table 2, and Schedule 4 Table 1 of the Consolidated Order of 2023 the revisions to introduce new hours of operation, charging periods, tariff changes for pay-on-foot and pay and display car parks and changes to business season ticket charges included on the table of Schedule 2, 3 and 4 of this Order.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from 1 April 2023 apply for the purpose to the High Court.
