# (CCC) Homeless

#### Response

Average current waiting times can only be calculated from households who have been housed rather than the 'live' households on the housing register. There are some questions on the housing register application form that relate to your questions for which I have provided responses below. Please note that sometime fields may not be completed.

Do any household members have a medical condition that is made worse by your current housing?

820 responses were recorded as "Yes".

Can you walk upstairs?

73 responses were recorded for "I cannot manage stairs or steps at all" 294 responses were recorded for "Stairs are difficult for me"

Can they walk upstairs?

10 responses were recorded for "I cannot manage stairs or steps at all"

32 responses were recorded for "Stairs are difficult for me"

Applicant Mobility Level

32 responses for 1, 16 wanted this level

85 response for 2, 13 wanted this level

329 responses for 3, 92 wanted this level, 2 of which had Level 2

Do you use a wheelchair?

47 responses were recorded as "Yes".

Do they use a wheelchair?

5 responses were recorded as "Yes".

It should be noted that any data on average current waiting times should be treated with caution. Actual time taken to rehouse individuals varies considerably. Figures will be affected by a number of factors, including: how often each applicant bids; which properties or areas applicants choose to bid on; priority given to bidders on new developments through local lettings plans; rent levels

being charged; suitability of properties for an applicant - e.g. sheltered or adapted properties. Armed forces applicants also affect the time average. Some figures can be given for previous years below by bands and bedroom sizes, which aimed to exclude those applicants where the bidding time may have been affected artificially though this is not guaranteed to be completely accurate. The methodology was revised for 2019-23 in an attempt to improve accuracy, though this is likely to make yearly comparisons even less accurate.

This is from 1 April 2019 to 31 March 2023 combined as breaking it down further by year would make the data less statistically significant bearing in mind the data warning already given.

755 responses were recorded as "Yes" with average waiting time of 382 days.

Can you walk upstairs?

71 responses were recorded for "I cannot manage stairs or steps at all" with average waiting time of 292 days.

## Can they walk upstairs?

11 responses were recorded for "I cannot manage stairs or steps at all" with average waiting time of 318 days.

38 responses were recorded for "Stairs are difficult for me" with average waiting time of 441 days.

### **Applicant Mobility Level**

23 responses for 1, with average waiting time of 400 days. 7 wanted this level, with average waiting time of 390 days, 2 of which had Level 2.

175 response for 2, with average waiting time of 382 days. 15 wanted this level, with average waiting time of 371days, 3 of which had Level 3.

225 responses for 3, with average waiting time of 352 days. 33 wanted this level, with average waiting time of 288 days, 1 of which had Level 2.

### Do you use a wheelchair?

43 responses were recorded as "Yes", with average waiting time of 382 days.

#### Do they use a wheelchair?

9 responses were recorded as "Yes", with average waiting time of 273 days.
