Getting disabled kids swimming



Free swimming lessons for disabled children in Cambridge

Level Water is offering free swimming lessons for disabled children. These lessons are for primary-aged children with a physical disability or sensory impairment. We do not currently work with children who have learning or behavioural difficulties.

Why free swimming?

Swimming is a great sport for these children, but it can be ineffective or unsafe for them to learn in mainstream groups. Level Water provides small group and one-to-one lessons until they are ready to join a mainstream class or competitive club.

How does it work?

We work in partnership with Better Leisure at pools like Parkside, Abbey and Kings Hedges. The teachers receive specialist disability training from the Amateur Swimming Association. They will then deliver your lessons as normal, but we cover the cost until your child is ready to move on.
