Section 1 Introduction

Publication Scheme

The Freedom of Information Act 2000 gives a right of public access to recorded information held by public authorities. The Freedom of Information Act requires every public authority to adopt and maintain a publication scheme, and to publish information in accordance with it.

All public authorities must adopt a Publication Scheme that is approved by the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO), the body responsible for protecting personal information and promoting access to official information.

Cambridge City Council has adopted the Publication Scheme approved by the Information Commissioner. It became effective 1 January 2009. In drawing up this scheme we have followed the guidelines given the definition document for Principal Local Authorities.

What is a publication scheme?

Cambridge City Council is committed to openness and actively seeks to make information available about how it works, its decision-making processes and the services it provides available online.

The Publication Scheme sets out the information we make available. It also provides details about

- How the information is made available
- How it can be obtained and
- Whether there are any charges for this information.

The Monitoring Officer is responsible for the Publication Scheme on behalf of Cambridge City Council. The Freedom of Information Officer is responsible for maintaining the scheme on a day-to-day basis. Contact details for both are given at the end of this document.

Review

The publication scheme is reviewed annually.

The next review of the publication scheme will take place before the end of March 2013.

Section 2 Guide to Information

How the Publication Scheme is organised

The publication scheme explains the information we currently make available. This information is split into seven classes of information. These are:

1. Who we are and what we do
 - Information about Cambridge City Council, our offices, structures and how to get in contact with us
2. What we spend and how we spend it
 - Financial information, our income and expenditure, contracts, procurement and financial audits
3. What our priorities are and how we are doing
 - Our strategies and plans and how we are performing
4. How we make decisions
 - Committee minutes and agendas and public consultations
5. Our policies and procedures
 - The policies and procedures used to deliver our services
6. Lists and registers
 - Public registers we hold and details of our asset registers
7. Services provided by the Council
 - Information about the services we provide

The classes of information are outlined in Section 3 of this document. Details of how the information is made available and any fees charged are also set out there. A paper copy of the scheme is also available at our main reception points.

The majority of the information in the publication scheme is available via our website. The publication scheme sets out the formats in which this information is available. An explanation of these formats is given below.

Online	Information made available online
On request	Information held by the Council but not available online
Leaflet	Information routinely made available in leaflets for the public.
Public inspection	Documents and registers that are available for inspection at our offices

Charges

Most information within the publication scheme is free. We do not charge for documents in an electronic format. If you require information to be supplied to you in paper copy we may make a charge for printing and postage. Our charges are outlined below,

- 10p per page for A4 copying or printing
- 20p per page for A3 copying or printing

- Postage will be charged at the rate for second class

We will not charge for printing and postage if the total cost is less than £10.

Accessibility

How the Publication Scheme works

Most of the information included in the publication scheme is published routinely on our website or related websites.

If you need to request a copy of the information on the publication scheme we will respond promptly, and no later than 5 working days after making your request. If the information is available on our website we will show you where it is. If it's not on our website we will provide you with the information. If the information forms part of our public registers we will let you know how you can arrange to see it.

Using information from Cambridge City Council

You may use and re-use the information featured on the council's website (not including logos) free of charge in any format or medium, under the terms of the [Open Government Licence](#).

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I ...

... Get information under the publication scheme?

Firstly look at the publication scheme document, this will help you identify whether the information you are looking for is included in the Scheme, and how it can be accessed. If you need to request the information from us you can contact the relevant department or the Freedom of Information Officer.

... Give feedback?

The publication scheme is a constantly changing document. It is reviewed regularly and amended as we make more information available on our website. If you have any comments or suggestions to make, please contact the Freedom of Information Officer. Contact details are given at the end of the document.

... Make a complaint?

If information in the publication scheme is not made available, either on our website or following a request then you should contact the Freedom of Information Officer. If you are still unhappy with the response you should contact the Monitoring Officer.

... Get information not included in the Publication Scheme?

If you want information not included in the Publication Scheme you can make a Freedom of Information request.

Freedom of Information requests have to be made in writing. You can make a request by e-mailing foi@cambridge.gov.uk, or by writing to the Freedom of Information officer. You will need to provide a return address for us to reply to (an e-mail address is usually sufficient).

We must respond to a Freedom of Information request within 20 working days of receiving it. If we hold the information that you are requesting then we will let you know, and will supply you with this information unless an exemption applies.

Does it cost anything to make a request?

Most of the information available under the Publication Scheme is available free of charge. We can charge for supplying paper copies of information. We will tell you if there is a fee for any information and why we are charging it.

What can't be requested under the Publication Scheme?

The Publication Scheme does not cover personal information. If you want a copy of your personal information then you can make a request for this under the Data Protection Act. Guidance on how to make a request is available on our website or from the main reception points. Who we are

Cambridgeshire has a two-tier system of local government. This means that two Councils provide services within the City. Cambridge City Council runs services such as planning, waste collection, housing, Arts & Entertainments and leisure services, whilst Cambridgeshire County Council is responsible for running services such as libraries, schools, highway maintenance and social care.
