

Residents Liaison Meeting - City Council Housing Developments at Mill Road Depot (Ironworks) and the former Ridgeon's site on Cromwell Road

Meeting Terms of Reference

1. Scope & Purpose

- To explain the role of Cambridge Investment Partnership (CIP) - a 50%-50% Joint Venture between the City Council and Hill Partnerships, the Council and Hill in the development process
- To give a time limited opportunity to provide accurate and timely face to face information and advice to residents, about progress with the development of the Ironworks scheme (former Mill Road Depot) and the former Ridgeon's site on Cromwell Road.
- To hear of, and consider, issues of interest for the existing and new communities around, and on, both development sites.
- To provide information and signposting on site progress and other issues, to a wider reach than what is currently delivered by Hills Resident Liaison Team
- To listen and pass on issues and concerns, and raise them to the relevant parties within CIP, the Council and Hill

2. Not Within the Scope

- Other local community issues
- Making decisions
- Challenging approved planning decisions

3. Structure and Management

- To provide timely, 'open to all' resident liaison meetings during the development process, and other forms of engagement where necessary.
- Communication – notifications prior to the meeting via web page, fliers to adjacent residential properties, existing publications and social media. Notes and presentations from the meetings will be published on the City Council and Cambridge Investment Partnership web pages
