








**Cambridge City Centre Recovery Plan – COVID-safe pedestrian and cycle measures**

**KEY: -**

-  Temporary barrier on carriageway to allow wider footway.
-  Advisory closure to vehicle and cycle access while outdoor market in operation.
-  Retain 1-way cycle access at all times.
-  Retain 2-way cycle access at all times.
-  Advisory 1-way cycle access at all times.
-  Advisory one way street / lane for pedestrians with signage and Social Distancing message.
-  Pedestrians on footways - Advisory keep on left on footway signage and Social Distancing message.

Pedestrians should always try and keep to the left unless directed otherwise by signage.

This plan only shows the highway changes introduced to support Covid-safe re-opening of the city centre. All other city centre highway regulations remain unchanged. If in doubt, please follow signage.

NOTE: - This is the current plan and is subject to change as people come back into the city.
