Operational budget was £1,013,400 (excluding capital deprecation) but including a Leisure Management Contract Fee budget of £705,525. Capital Depreciation on these budgets in 2012 was £1,400,580

b. 2020 (so the 2019/2020 budget)

Operational budget is £782,753 (excluding capital deprecation) but including a Leisure Management Contract Fee budget of £543,834 Capital Depreciation on these budgets is currently £1,229,430

- 2. I would also like to know how many of the following facilities were owned/operated by the council for the above two years (so January 2012 and January 2020) please:
- Public swimming pools. Also, how many of these pools are Olympic-sized?

2012 - 4 Pools

2020 - (the same) 4 Pools

None are Olympic sized with the biggest indoor facility being an 8 lane 25m Pool and a 100yard (93m) long outdoor Lido.

Public athletics tracks (2012 and 2020)

Cambridge City Council do not own or manage any Athletic tracks - Zero budget

Public cycling tracks/velodromes (2012 and 2020)

Cambridge City Council do not own or manage any cycling tracks or Velodromes - Zero budget

• Public playing fields / football rugby pitches does the council own/operate (2012 and 2020). This does not need to be broken down by size etc.
