

For the last five financial years, and the current financial year to date, the number of times an elected councillor requested a planning application to be referred to the planning committee and the outcome of that request. The outcome can be: a) successfully referred; b) not referred. For those 'not referred' I would like to know the reason, and frequency of that reason, including the request being considered outside the defined period by the planning officer and therefore not considered for referral.

We ascertain the Council does not hold the information you seek.

Any request for a planning determination, to be decided at committee, is taken to committee (there is no nomination and decision process). City doesn't have the equivalent of a Chairman's delegation in South Cambs, so any request for an application to go to committee would be sent.
