The Greater Cambridge Partnership (GCP) aims to create better and greener transport networks, connecting people to homes, jobs, study and opportunity.

Access to Cambridge from the east has been identified by our Executive Board as one of four high quality public transport routes into Cambridge that could also form an integral part of the Cambridgeshire Autonomous Metro (CAM).

The Cambridge Eastern Access project is looking at access to and from the city from the east to enable people to get around more easily by public transport, cycle or on foot.

The project aims and objectives are to:

- Identify a variety of options which will improve the reliability, safety, capacity and speed of sustainable transport connections for those accessing Cambridge from the east;
- Improve connections between existing settlements and identify the best measures that could be put in place to ensure connections are in

place at the opening of new developments, thereby reducing the need for trips to be made by private car.
