

Self-Registration on Modern.Gov – Guide for the Public

Cambridge City Council has a software system called Modern.Gov to manage committees, members and other parts of the democratic process.

The system allows members of the public to register (and unregister) to receive email updates about committees or issues related to one or more ward.
