Response:

In terms of the three main skating parks in the city, these were delivered via bespoke projects on a design and build basis (inc the elements of Design/Labour/Materials) with the following sums attached;

£55K Jesus Green

£65K Cherry Hinton

£65K Nuns Way

Post construction the City Council are responsible for the maintenance of these facilities. This has been periodic in nature and minor repairs delivered internally and difficult therefore to make accurate projections on costs involved.

With regards to the Orchard Park skate facility I can confirm that this is not within our administrative boundary but under the jurisdiction of South Cambridgeshire District Council. As the areas of open space did not get transferred to City Council there is no information on this so South Cambridgeshire would be the best point of contact to further this part of the request.

In terms of the Riverside link, again we don't hold any information regarding these works as I believe they were undertaken by Cambridgeshire County Council, again suggested contact onward in respect of this particular information.
