Is the council's set of Tree Preservation Orders (TPOs) indexed in digital form? If so, if you hold the GIS data relating to trees subject to TPOs, a shapefile or the longitude and latitude that you might use for an interactive council map would be ideal.

I would be appreciative if you could send me the data you hold relating to the above regarding the location of the trees subject to TPO's.

Response:

The council does hold GIS data relating to trees subject to TPOs. A zip file containing shapefiles is attached (available on request)

The information within these map layers is indicative only and is subject to change. If you are intending to carry out any works to trees then you should either inspect the original copy of the Tree Preservation or contact Cambridge City Council to check the protection status of the tree/s. If you do not then you risk prosecution if the tree is protected.

The spatial data supplied is captured using Ordnance Survey maps and data. Provision of this information does not automatically infer the right to copy publish or alter the information. You will need to ensure that you have the correct licences in place to make use of derived spatial data.
