Thank you for your request of 16 November. Your request has been considered under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and the Environmental Information Regulations 2004.

Your request was for

A copy of planning application correspondence and documentation related and actual material. regarding directly or indirectly 54 Tenison road Cambridge CB1 2DW.

All planning application correspondence and documentation is available on the planning portal which can be accessed via our website at <https://www.cambridge.gov.uk/view-and-comment-on-a-planning-application>.

The planning portal contains records of applications for planning permission to 52 Tenison Road. We do not have the ability to make searches of the planning register for phrases contained in documents so are unable to search for information relating 'indirectly' to the address, although residents of 52 Tenison Road would be on the lists of neighbours notified for planning applications on nearby properties. This would be in line with our planning application process (<https://www.cambridge.gov.uk/the-planning-application-process>). Map searches of the planning portal would show you which nearby addresses have submitted applications.

Your request also singled out black and white photos that the council took of 56 Tenison Road following a retrospective planning application. Having looked at the relevant planning application I can see that these were scanned and uploaded to this planning application. I am unable to verify if the council holds the original file that was scanned in as it would only exist on the paper copy of the planning file. These files are kept in offsite storage, and whilst most council officers are not working in the office we are unable to recall historic planning files from offsite storage (see <https://www.cambridge.gov.uk/view-and-comment-on-a-planning-application> for confirmation of this).
