

(CCC) Public Toilets

How much money public toilets have made during the past year during the pandemic

I would like information on:

1. The names of all parks which have public toilets where there is a fee for the public to use them and how many public toilets in the proximity of each park
2. How much money each trip to each public toilet in the locations specified above costs
3. How much money the public toilets, in the locations as specified above (in proximity in a park or within a park), made between the dates of 23.3.20 and 10.3.21
4. How is payment taken for these public toilets? (eg: cash, card, contactless, or both)

Response:

1. Arbury Court Play Area, Christ's Pieces (Drummer Street), Parker's Piece (Gonville Place) where fee to use exists. There are no public toilets nearby at Arbury Court, Christ's Pieces next nearest toilet is Lion Yard, Parker's Piece next nearest toilet is Drummer Street.
2. Cost per visit is 20p
3. Arbury Court £36. Drummer Street £2500. Gonville Place £1200. Approximate annual incomes for period stated.
4. All are coin only payment.
