- Building up local sense of identity use of arts and heritage – annual Marleigh event



Partnership

- Building awareness of this work amongst key partners and supporting their contribution to it
- Core partner group
- Wider partner engagement
- Ensure service providers build up understanding of the needs of this new community and are accessible to new residents



Legacy

- Build self-sustaining legacy for the work
- Resident supported to serve themselves going forward
- Residents up-skilled as needed to bring in resources and advocate for itself going forwards
- Importance of linking structure to other key partners
- New structure/vehicle e.g. Community Development Trust?


