

### **(CCC) Holly Hill Development**

I regularly walk through Kettles Yard and along St Peter's Street and am aware of the properties on Holly Hill. I understand they are flats and bungalows for the elderly and have now spotted a plaque on one building recording their opening many years ago by the then Mayor.

I have not been able to find any information about them on the Council website 's housing pages

1. Are they still a Council responsibility?
2. If not who manages them? Some of the bungalows seem to be empty and in rather poor condition so thought to inform the relevant people
3. How are tenancies allocated?
4. Are any bungalows owner occupied?

### **Response**

I think the area you are referring to is call Honey Hill. Cambridge City Council own properties, 1-10 Honey Hill which are a combination of flats and bungalows. The properties are our responsibility and fall under our housing management and maintenance.

All our social housing tenancies are allocated via a system called Home-Link. More information about the process can be found on the following webpage-

Once registered, each applicant is banded depending on their need and individual requirements. They are then able to bid for available properties. If the bid is successful the property is allocated to that individual. They can only bid on properties that are available on Home-Link at that time.
