



**THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE (PUBLIC OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)
(AMENDMENT NO. 5) ORDER 2026**

Notice is hereby given that Cambridge City Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) (as amended) and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the Cambridgeshire County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (as amended) and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police intend making the above-named Order.

1. The effect of this Order is to amend the City of Cambridge (Public Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidated) Order 2023 as follows:
 - a) Schedule 3 Table 1 and Table 2, and Schedule 4 Table 1 of the Consolidated Order of 2023 is substituted with Schedule 1,2,3,4 and 5 of this Order respectively
 - b) In Schedule 2 Table 4 of the Consolidated Order 2023, the parking place at Clay Farm Community Centre shall be removed from Schedule 2 Table 4 and inserted into Schedule 2 Table 3 as a permit holder designated off-street parking place reflecting Schedule 6 of this Amendment Order
