The Community Chest

Small pots of funding **up to £250** available to kick-start community projects in and around the new communities

- 42 successfully funded projects Funds available for up to 36 new projects

Capacity Building

- Work with local community / voluntary sector
- Increase ownership of spaces, buildings, events + activities
- Time Credits programme
- SF working group of professionals



Trumpington Community Drama group

- Started with 12 children
- Fully funded and staffed by Council
- 4 years on:
- Performed 7 shows in local community
- Independent bank account + Constitution
- Attendees pay small termly fee
- Parent committee
- Grants / fundraising
- Council now only fund staff costs

- On other local activities and opportunities
